




Airport Loop Bike Ride Route Overview

Proposed Future Trail Routes Overlaid

- Start/Finish Bridgeport Central Baptist Church 9039 W. Washington St. Indianapolis
- One 10-mile loop around Indianapolis International Airport (police escorted)
- 10-mile alternate on N. & W. Perimeter Roads only
- 5-mile ride mostly on W. Perimeter Road
- 20-mile ride options
 - combine 10-mile loop & 10-mile alternate
 - two 10-mile alternates



White Lick Creek Greenway –


~8-miles (south 3 miles in initial study). Follows the meandering East Fork of the White Lick Creek on the western edge of Marion County, to connect with the Vandalia Trail, the B&O Trail, the Eagle Creek Trail, and Plainfield's associated greenway trail, as well as several parks and many neighborhoods, while passing under historic bridges and through natural habitat areas.
